

The expedition will be a solo expedition of the project's author, although he will be accompanied by his son. The author is 48 years old, Marceli is 12. He will also train for the expedition alone, to show that everyone must fight their own weaknesses on their own. He may have some assistance, but nobody will cycle for him.

Using the Summer Olympics is intended, to lend some of its media coverage to the project's objective, to utilize the interest the Summer Olympics will enjoy right before they start. The Summer Olympics are also an incentive, a clearly determined point in time get in perfect shape to.

The route will take us across Poland, Germany, the Netherlands, Belgium and France. Major cities along the route are Poznań, Berlin, Bremen, Amsterdam, Brussels, Paris. The route was planned based on existing international cycling routes.

Main project objective:

We want to buy **100** bicycles for children from orphanages, children in foster care and low income families. We want to raise PLN 100 / \leq 25 per kilometer covered.

$1,850 \text{ km} \times \text{PLN } 100 = \text{PLN } 185,000 / \text{ } 45,000$

The bicycles will be purchased in a tender.

We want to distribute the bicycles by December 2024.

- To promote a healthy life style among children and adolescents; we want to raise awareness of the issue of obesity among children and adults;
- Promotion of bicycle touring; we want to raise awareness of bicycle touring safety;
- To promote traffic regulations; we want to raise awareness of cycling training safety; to carry the message of UN Decade Action for Road Safety 2021-2030;
- To promote Mazowieckie province, to promote "Moda na Mazowsze" tourism project;
- To promote statutory operations of the "Roads of Mazovia" Foundation.

Obesity level among children

Obesity has been considered a disease and incorporated in the International Classification of Diseases (ICD-10): World Health Organisation report indicates that 32% Polish children aged 7-9 were reported obese. That means Poland is ranked 8 in Europe (amongst the countries covered by the survey).

Only 6% children under the age of 12 can do basic sports routines. The others have motor fitness deficiencies.

A moderate physical activity, i.e. at least one hour a day of physical activity 7 days a week (WHO recommendations) was achieved by: in 2013 - 21%, 2018 - 15%, 2022 - 12% students aged 11-17.



Training safety

There is no single year without hearing of a tragedy when training. Regardless of country, the scenario is always the same: a cyclist dies hit by a car.

Tijl De Decker, 22 y.o., is dead. A tragical accident at a training. [2023]

Adrián Babič, a two times European champion in mountain biking, the Slovak was hit by a car when training. [2022]

Rita Malinkiewicz and Katarzyna Konwa were hit by a car. The women have been struggling for their lives for a long time. [2021]

Desiet Kidane died in a car accident during one of her trainings. [2021]

Anna Karbowniczak was fatally hit by a car when cycling. [2020]

Danna Ortiz, a promising cyclist from Columbia. She was hit by a truck, she died.[2019]













Our survey

In 2023, we delivered a "Karta rowerowa dla Mazowsza. Pruszków" project. We taught children about traffic regulations in schools of Pruszków county. The classes were attended by 3,200 students.

As part of the classes, we made a survey, which reveals that some 25% 4th graders in Pruszków have no bicycle at all, they have nothing to learn on to take their cycling license exam.


At least 1 child per class admits they cannot ride a bicycle at all. Children ride bicycles dating 40 years back.
